

PROJECT OVERVIEW



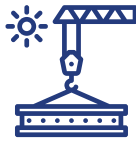
- Revive I-70 is an INDOT project to improve and expand I-70 in Wayne County.

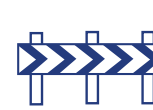



CONTRACT 1 QUANTITIES

- 585,000+** square yards of new pavement
- 400,000+** cubic yards of excavation
- 350,000+** tons of aggregates on grade
- 114,000+** square feet bridge widening/rehabs
- 41,000+** square feet of new bridge deck
- 35,000+** square feet of retaining wall
- 31,000+** feet of new drainage structures
