- Revive I-70 is an INDOT project to improve and expand I-70 in Wayne County.
- The 20+ mile corridor runs from west of Cambridge City to the IN/OH state line.
- The project is expected to reduce congestion, improve traffic flow, and improve safety.

Contract 1 improvements include added travel lanes, interchange modifications and pavement replacement.

- **114,000+** square feet bridge widening/rehabs
- **41,000+** square feet of new bridge deck
- **35,000+** square feet of retaining wall
- **31,000+** feet of new drainage structures
